

Temporary Food License Fee Guidance

Menu Risk Category	2020 License Fee Five or more day notice	2020 Late License Fee Less than five day notice
<p>Low Risk Menu: <u>No cooking</u> of vegetables, pasta, raw meat, fish, eggs or poultry. <u>No cutting</u> of raw fruit or vegetables. Only heating commercially packaged foods.</p> <p>Examples: Pre-cooked hot dogs and brats, snow cones, cotton candy, popcorn, ice cream, nachos with cheese sauce, commercially packaged pizza</p>	<p>Non-Profit: \$70</p> <p>For-Profit: \$74</p>	<p>Non-Profit: \$105.00</p> <p>For-Profit: \$111.00</p>
<p>Medium and High Risk Menu: <u>Cooking</u> meat, fish, eggs, poultry, vegetables, pasta. <u>Cutting</u> raw fruit or vegetables.</p> <p>Examples: Sub sandwiches, salad luncheon, hamburgers, spaghetti dinner, chicken BBQ, soup or chili, fish boil</p>	<p>Non-Profit: \$90</p> <p>For-Profit: \$94</p>	<p>Non-Profit: \$135.00</p> <p>For-Profit: \$141.00</p>

NOTE: A \$100 surcharge applies for more than 3 (three) temporary food service licenses per year.
